Grants available

- Empowering Communities up to £3,000

For small projects, equipment and one-off events. These grants aim to encourage residents and small local groups to deliver projects to benefit communities.

- Creating Sustainability between £3,000 and £10,000

This grant can be applied for up to a period of three years and is aimed at established groups who wish to develop longer term projects.

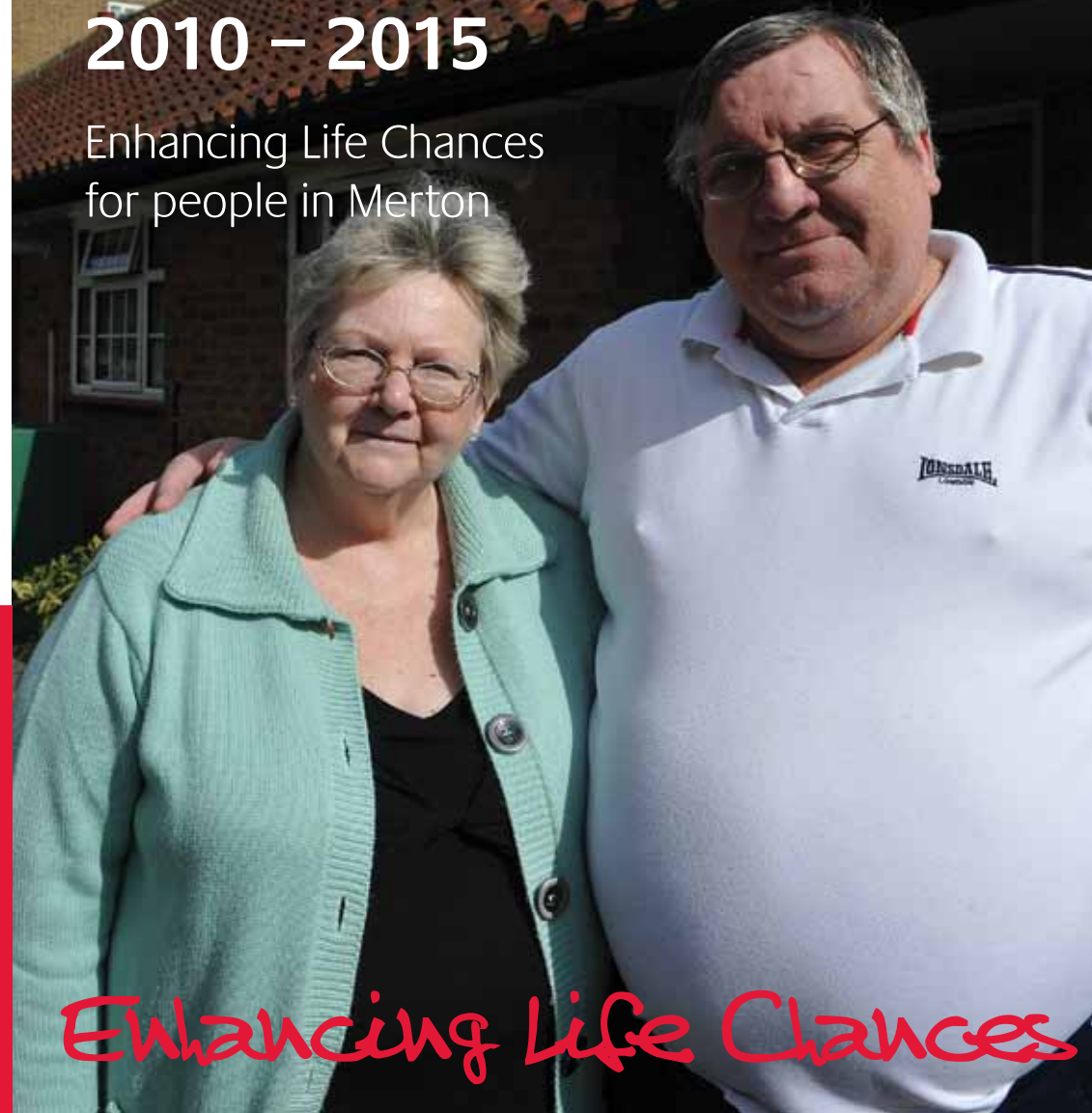
